Established in 1972 as a College of Physical Education, Government Graduate College for Women, Township, gained independent status and expanded its academic scope in 2008 with the addition of Intermediate and Degree programs in general education.

 Spanning 18 acres, 3 Kanals, and 15 marlas, the college is a unique institution in Pakistan, offering both Physical and General Education. To ensure security, it is equipped with surveillance cameras, alarms, fire extinguishers, security personnel, and a panic button.

Recognizing the growing student body, the Punjab Government approved infrastructure expansion in 2015-16, leading to the completion of a new academic building. Since 2018-19, the college has been operating from its upgraded facilities, which now include **six independent blocks**.

- Academic Blocks Science Block, BS Block, Old & New Admin Blocks
- Sports Facilities A multipurpose gymnasium, basketball court, hockey ground, football ground, and a 400-meter athletic track.
- Support Facilities A water filtration plant, tube well, mosque, daycare center, dispensary, and staff parking, a burqa room for students, a canteen, and a college bus.

The **New Block** features four fully equipped science labs, a computer lab, a library, a seminar room, a career counseling center, and a smart classroom(2024). A four-room extension already became functional in 2022, enhancing academic facilities further.

With state-of-the-art infrastructure and a commitment to excellence, the college continues to provide a dynamic learning environment for young women.

Dear Parents and Students,

Please read the college prospectus thoroughly before filling out the admission form.

The college will not be responsible for any errors made by applicants.

- Only the admission form attached to the college prospectus will be accepted.
- Students applying for multiple categories must submit separate forms for each.
- Admissions will be granted according to the Government of Punjab's admission policy.

Conditions for Admission (Intermediate)

- Submit the specific admission form for the chosen stream: Science, Arts, General Science, or ICS (Physics/Statistcs).
- Sports Quota: Available for F.A. students only. Attach a sports distinction certificate with the admission form.
- Disabled Quota: Attach a disability certificate issued by the relevant authority.
- Minority Quota: Available for both Arts and Science students.
 Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria and qualify the entry test where applicable.
- 5. Hafiz e Quran quota.

Required Documents:

- 1. Matric result marks sheet (copy)
- 2. Four attested photographs (1.5 x 1.5 inches)
 - · One front-facing photo
 - Three attested on the back

3. Photo background requirements:

- F.A./F.Sc.: White background
- BS programs: Blue background

Documents to be Submitted After Admission

Students must submit the following documents after securing admission:

- Matric Result Card-Original with three attested photocopies.
- Character Certificate-Original with three attested photocopies.
- Father/Guardian's CNIC Three attested photocopies.
- Applicant's CNIC/Form-B Three attested photocopies.
- NOC (No Objection Certificate) Required for students who
 passed Matric from any BISE other than Lahore Board.
 Submitthe original NOC with three photocopies in time.
- 6. O-Level Students:
 - Must apply manually as per the concerned Board's schedule.
 - Submit an Equivalence Certificate issued by PBCC along with documents (2 to 5).

Important Notes:

- Admissions will be granted strictly on a merit basis.
- Parents/guardians are solely responsible for any illegal dealings with college officials, officers, or teachers.

Admission for Previous Session Students:

1. Admission may be granted on hardship/compassionate

OCAS (Online College Admission System)

grounds with a **one-year session gap**, subject to the **Principal's approval** based on the Admission Committee's recommendations.

- Formal registration approval must be obtained from the Chairman of BISE.
- College Council must provide formal approval for registration.
- Admissions for Graduation and Post-Graduation will be subject to the rules of the respective university.
- Admissions will be granted strictly on merit. Candidates must submit an affidavit confirming that they were not enrolled in any institution between their year of passing and the year of application.

Submission of Admission to BISE

- Students with less than 75% attendance or absent in first and second year college exams will not have their admissions submitted to BISE.
- Roll number slips will not be issued to students absent from classes as per the schedule.
- Students with two or more failing grades (F) in internal assessments will be ineligible for the annual board exams.

Online Admission Process for F.A, General Science, F.Sc, ICS (Physics/Statistcs)

Online College Admission System (OCAS) provides an easy and affordable online system for intermediate admissions:

- Processing Fee: Rs. 25/- per application.
- Multiple College Applications: Students can apply to multiple colleges by paying the fee separately for each.

 Merit List Generation: The student's name will automatically appear in the online merit list of the selected college.

Students admitted to the second shift must pay an additional Rs. 300/- per month as tuition fee, in addition to the regular charges applicable to morning classes.

Rules & Regulations (for second shift students).

- Shift Change Policy: Students admitted in the evening shift cannot transfer to the morning shift, except those who qualify within the morning shift merit of their respective discipline subject to the availability of seat.
- Campus Restrictions: Evening shift students must not be present on campus before their shift starts; violators will be fined.
- 3. Uniform Distinction: The college uniform for the evening shift differs from that of the morning shift.
- Identity Card: Evening shift students will be issued a different-colored ID card from morning shift students.
- 5. **Disciplinary Action:** Failure to comply with college rules and regulations may lead to expulsion from the college.

RULES & REGULATIONS

SUBJECT/GROUP CHANGE POLICY

- 1. **Subject Change:** Students must visit the BISE Lahore office personally for any subject change. The college does not facilitate this process.

- Migration from other cities is generally not permitted due to limited seat availability. However, under unavoidable circumstances (e.g., job transfer or relocation), requests may be considered in accordance with the Government's merit policy.

Note: As per the Government of Punjab's policy, local

STUDENT LEAVE RULES

The following leave rules must be observed:

- Leave is granted only in genuine cases. The student must submit a written application, signed by the parents, to the Principal.
- Leave should be applied on the prescribed page of the Leave Book, available at the clerical office.
- A maximum of 2 leaves per month can be approved by English and Urdu teachers. For more than 2 leaves, permission must be obtained from the Principal or an authorized official.
- Medical Leave must be supported by a medical certificate issued by a Government hospital's Medical Superintendent (MS) or an authorized Medical Attendant.
- Approved leaves will NOT be counted as presents in the attendance record.
- Continuous absence of 15+ days will result in the student being struck off the college roll.
- A student who fails to join the college after the start of the academic session will not be eligible for board admission submission.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR BS PROGRAMS

Class Attendance:

- A student must have attended at least 75% of the classes held in a course in order to be allowed to sit in the final examination.
- In case the student remains absent from the class for seven consecutive days without leave his/her name will be removed the roll.
- Students having less than 75% class attendance in a
 particular course will be required to repeat the course in
 the same semester next year. Names of such students will
 be reported by the college to the University of the Punjab
 and these students shall not be allowed to appear in the
 final examination.

Promotion Rules:

- A student must obtain a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.00 at the end of each semester for promo-tion to next semester.
- 2. In case a student is able to obtain GPA of 1.70 or more but less than 2.00 except first semester where GPA of 1.50 or more but less than 2.00, he/she will be promoted to the next Semester on probation (1st probation). If the student does not achieve the desired CGPA of 2.00 but obtain CGPA greater than or equal to 1.70, will go to 2nd (last) probation. The candidate, who fails to secure 1.50 GPA in the first semester or 1.70 CGPA in a subsequent semester, will stand automatically dropped from the rolls of the college.
- A student will have the right to avail probation twice in the following semesters.

- A student has to obtain CGPA 2.00 in the first semester of each program for award of degree.
- In third, fifth, seventh, and ninth (where applicable) semesters a student will be required to repeat those courses of the first, third, fifth, and seventh semesters, respectively, in which he/she had failed.
- In the forth, sixth, eighth and tenth (where applicable) semester, a student will be required to repeat those courses of the second, fourth, sixth, and eighth semesters, respectively, in which he/she had failed.
- If a student gets D grade, he/she can repeat the course when offered to improve his/her grade.
- 8. A student, who completes all courses and has not been required to repeat any course(s), obtains CGPA less than 2.00 but no less than 1.90 at the end of 8th semester may be allowed to repeat 12 credit in which he/she had obtained the lowest grades, in order to improve the CGPA so as to obtain the minimum of 2.00 CGPA failing which he/she shall not be allowed degree and removed from the rolls of the college.
- In case a student repeats the course(s) for the improvement of grade(s) which he/she has already taken, the better of the two grades of the course(s) will be counted for CGPA calculations.

Probation:

The probation of a student on probation will be allowed twice in all degree programs. If a student in the first semester obtains CGPA less than 2.00 and greater than or equal to 1.5, he/she will be considered on probation. In the subsequent semesters (i.e, second semester onwards), the student will be

on probation if he/she secured CGPA less than 2.00, and greater than or equal to 1.70. In case student does not achieved the minimum desired CGPA 2.00 in any semester afer availing two probations, he/she will be dropped from the rolls of the College and cannot be re-admitted by the same College under any circumstances.

Course Workload and Change of Course:

- A student who had earned an 'F' grade in a course in first semester may be allowed to take one additional course during the third semester.
- A student who had earned an 'F' grade in a course in the 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th or 6th semester may be allowed to take one additional course during the 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th or 8th semester, respectively.
- The student who had earned an 'F' grade in course 7th and 8th semester will enroll again in 7th and 8th semester of next class (i.e., the following year).
- The student who had earned an 'F' grade in any course or have earned 'D' grade in any course and want to improve grade will enroll the course in the same semester in the following year.

Unfair Means Cases:

The teacher-in-charge will report unfair means cases in quizzes and mid semester examinations to the Principal who will forward these cases to College Examination Committee within one week for necessary action as under:

Any candidate detected in giving or receiving, or found guilty of copying from any paper, book or note, or allowing any other candidate to copy his answer book, or using, or attempting to use these or any other unfair means, will be dropped from the

program not exceeding two semester.

UMCs in the final examination will be handled by the office of the Controller of the Examinations, University of the Punjab, as per university rules.

Re-Take Examination:

If a student fails in a course, he/she will be provided two chances to pass a course by registering for the course again in the same semester of the subsequent years. If a student fails to pass the course after availing these two chances, he/she will be dropped from the rolls of the college.

Freezing of a Semester:

In case of valid reason a student may freeze his/her studies maximum for one year (two semester)subject to the permission of Chairperson/Principal of the concerned Department/College. The student will rejoin the same semester in the following year. However, freezing in 1st semester not allowed.

Cancellation of Admission:

If a student fails to attend any lecture during the first four weeks of the commencement of the semester asper announced schedule, his/her admission stand cancelled automatically without any notice.
